The Madonna Foundation's Madonna Scholars Program promotes empowerment, academic achievement and a path to college for 65 teen girls from disadvantaged and minority backgrounds. These scholars attend one of our six all-girls Catholic partner high schools in the Chicago area. We award scholarships to students of all faiths who demonstrate financial need and a desire for academic success. The crucial combination of scholarship support and dynamic programming enables our scholars to reach their full potential and achieve their longterm academic goals. Without scholarships from the Madonna Foundation, the teen girls we serve would not have the ability to achieve their full potential. As students from first-generation and minority backgrounds, they face barriers. Our programming helps them overcome these barriers and acquire the confidence, critical skills and competencies needed for success in high school, college and beyond. Tutoring, college visits, career days, ACT preparation classes, financial literacy training, STEAM workshops and summer internships comprise our key programming components.
